Recurve Bowman male and female 30 m

Recurve Yeoman male and female 20 m

All Arrows Shot At One Distance & on a 122cm target face

All compounds shoot 80 cm target. Each person gets individual target.
Compound Cadet, Junior, Senior, and Master male and female 50 m

Compound Cub male and female 30 m

Compound Bowman male and female 25 m

Compound Yeoman male and female 20 m

All Arrows Shot At One Distance

ENTRY FEE: \$35.00 per person.....pre-registration before August 17th
